All applicants are required to submit the following, regardless of whether they wish to attend the entire session (4  $\frac{1}{2}$  weeks), or the Teachers' Seminar (2 weeks) only:

- Completed application form. Please indicate whether you are attending the full session or the Lehrerseminar only.
- 2. A short statement (in either German or English) describing your reasons for applying and your teaching experience. Applicants who have attended the German Summer School of New Mexico previously do not need to submit a letter.
- 3. A **non-refundable** \$400 application fee/deposit. This deposit will be deducted from the total costs of the program if you are accepted to the Summer School. If you are not accepted into the program your deposit will be refunded.

Unfortunately, we are unable to take credit/debit cards for the \$400 deposit.

Applications without the deposit are considered incomplete and will not be reviewed.

A modest number of scholarships will be available to high school teachers of German. Applicants desiring financial aid should submit all of the above plus the completed financial aid forms: the German Summer School Application for Scholarship Aid & a FAFSA (<a href="http://www.fafsa.ed.gov">http://www.fafsa.ed.gov</a>). Since we are using the same scholarship application form for all applicants, please disregard any questions that do not apply to you.
